Program Focus

Comprehensive arts and sciences background and advanced study in state-of-the-art, technologically advanced management practices

Program Format

Thirteen course modules totaling 60 credits: Four arts and sciences courses; nine management courses; and a three-credit strategy seminar

Course Schedule

- Organizational Behavior and Dynamics
(Intensive four-day course to kick off program, Wednesday-Saturday 9 a.m.–6 p.m.)
- Tuesday evening 6–9 p.m.; Thursday 6–9 p.m. (alternating); Saturday 9 a.m.–4 p.m. (alternating)
- July and August—no classes

Admission Criteria

Applicants are selected based on academic background and professional experience, and are expected to have completed a minimum of 65 transferable college semester credits and have five years of work experience.

Admission Requirements

- Completed Boston University Metropolitan College Undergraduate Application
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, issued directly from each institution
- Official high school transcript(s) or copy of GED
- Current resume detailing the progression of your professional work experience
- A personal statement of 500 words, as requested in the Boston University Undergraduate Application
- A nonrefundable \$75 application fee, made payable to Boston University

Application Deadline

Note that this is a rolling admissions process, so it is best to apply early.

Tuition

Current cost per credit is \$340 plus a \$40 registration fee each semester.
